Explanation of Classes

Series: NA (1990 – 1997), NB (1999 – 2005), NC (2006 - 2009)

Weather allowing, cars will be judged top down (except those with DHT), hood open, and trunk open. Cars will be judged on interior, trunk, exterior, and engine compartment.

Three judges provided by TCMC Events Director/Coordinator will select Best Of Show and Survivor. **Participants registered** in the 3rd annual ZTMOET **car show** will select the remaining classes. **Peoples Choice** will be selected by all participants and spectators at the show.

Best of Show

The Best of Show car will be chosen first and then taken out of further competition.

Survivor

Survivor will be (NA) class only and must have 100,000 miles or more..

Class: (Stock – daily driven) – SHINE AND SHOW

This class is the basic judging class created for all 3 generations of Miata's. Car will be classified as Stock if vehicle is all original from the factory with no modifications. This class is intended for the well-maintained frequent and/or daily driver. Cars in this class will be judged for quality of workmanship, cleanliness, and condition. Parts are allowed as is "natural" spray paint, provided that the part maintains its' original appearance. Hoods and trunks must be left open or all points of those areas will be lost.

Class: M/LM (Modified/Lightly-Modified)

Car will be classified as Modified to Lightly Modified if you have one (or more) of the following:

- Lowered suspension
- Engine dress up (powder-coated, chromed, painted engine compartment pieces; or colored hoses)
- After market non-generation wheels
- Audio (example: change out head unit)
- Change of shift knob and/or parking brake handle
- Cool air intake/factory approved (example: Racing Beat {K&N Filter}/MazdaSpeed)

Class: HM (Highly-Modified)

Car will be classified as Highly Modified category **IF** a car has forced induction (other than 04/05 Mazdaspeed) **OR** non-factory body kits modifications **OR** custom paint/any repaint to a non-generation color is automatically **HIGHLY MODIFIED**.

Without any of those items above, **IF** a car has any 3 of the items below, it is **HIGHLY MODIFIED**:

- Upholstered trunk
- Engine dress up (powder-coated, chromed, painted engine compartment pieces, or colored hoses)
- Any video components, large audio/video installs, aftermarket amp, sub woofer, DVD and/or video camera
- Aftermarket or non-generation seats or upholstery
- Non-stock gauges
- Modified doors
- Roll bars
